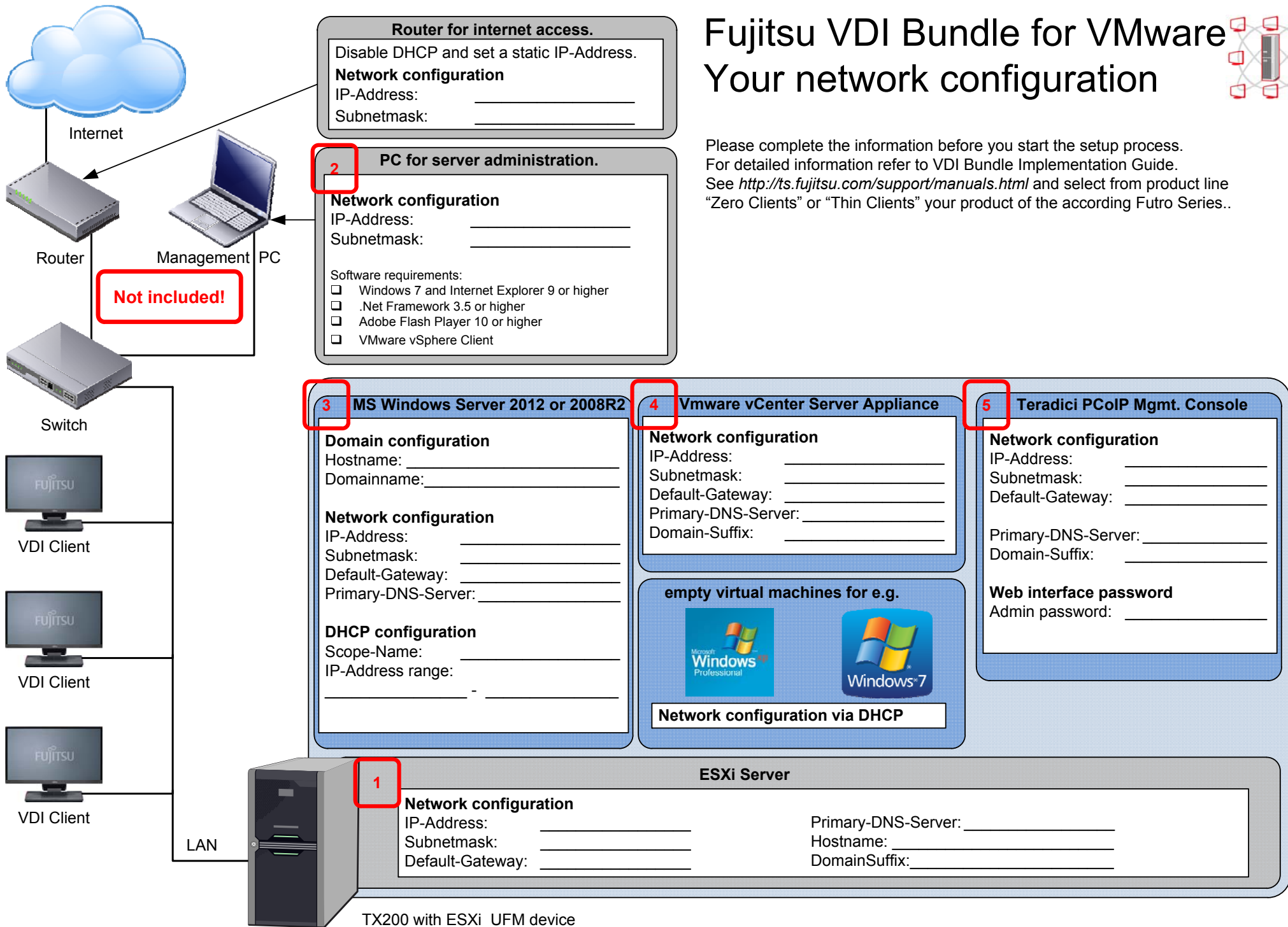

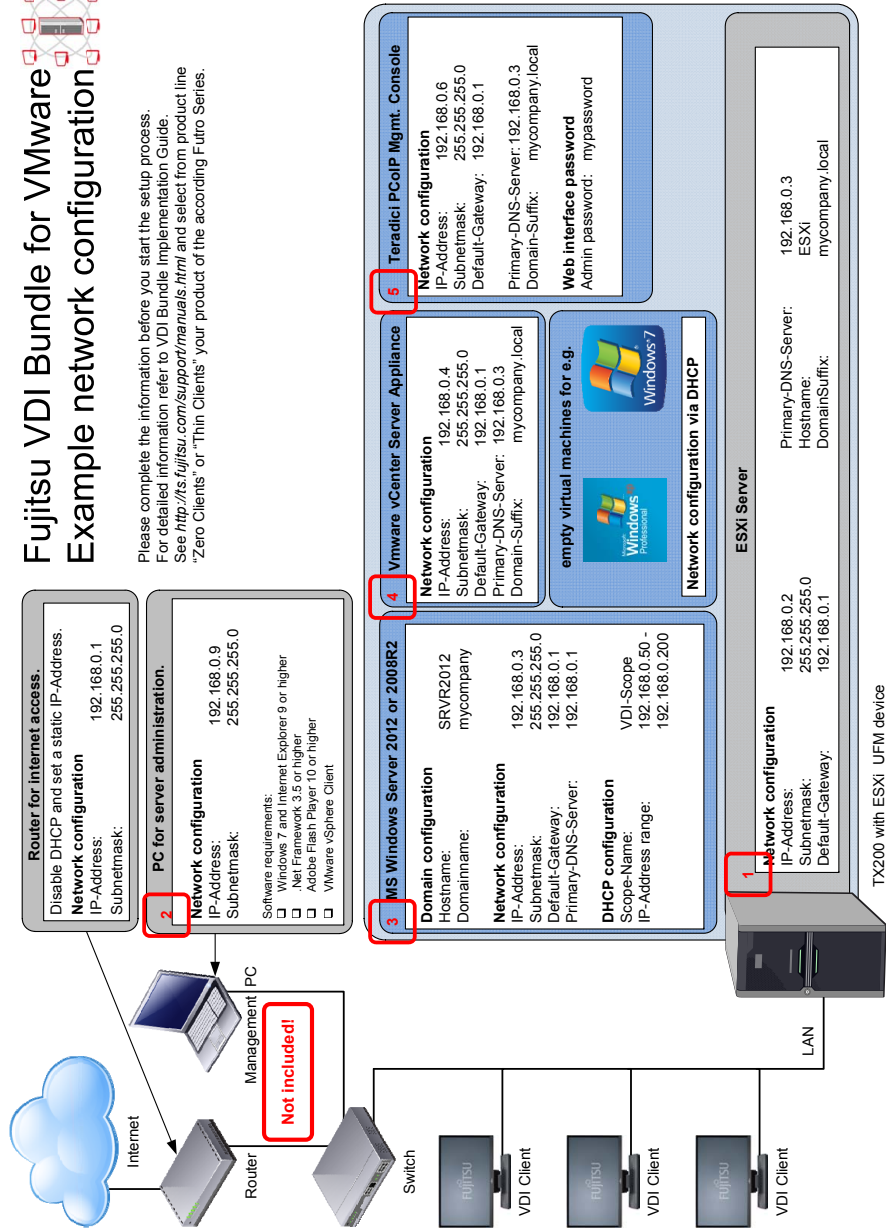

- Step 1**
 - Unbox all components and prepare hypervisor hardware (server)
 - Plan your installation and complete "Your network configuration" template
 - Prepare Management PC and Internet Router - not included in package
- Step 2**
 - Connect all cables such as LAN and power cable, keyboard and monitor to hypervisor hardware > power on server
- Step 3**
 - Initial configuration of hypervisor > set default password, network and keyboard configuration
- Step 4**
 - Install VMware vSphere Client > follow download link on hypervisors website and install on your management computer
- Step 5**
 - Configure datastores of hypervisor > start vSphere Client and add datastore
- Step 6**
 - Inventory of preinstalled virtual machines > vSphere Client: browse datastores and inventory of prepared virtual machines
- Step 7**
 - Set up Microsoft Windows Server > start virtual Windows Server and finish installation > setup Active Directory, DNS and DHCP scope and options
- Step 8**
 - Initial setup of VMware vCenter Server Appliance > power on, set up default password and network configuration > vCenter Server web-console: set up directory and virtualization configuration.
- Step 9**
 - (optional) Initial setup of Teradici PCoIP Management Console > power on, set up network configuration and change web interface password > PCoIP Management web-console: manage your PCoIP clients (e.g. Futro L420 / L620, ...)
- Step 10**
 - Prepare Desktop Virtual Machines (DVMs) > assign installation media (XP/Win7) to virtual machines CD drive and start installation > add to domain, install VMware Tools.
- Step 11**
 - Connect VDI Client Devices > configure VDI clients
